Two further awards will recognise individuals:

1. An award given by the ARP Council to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the UK Relocation Industry
2. An award for an individual who has recently joined the industry. **Members may nominate a colleague, employee or individual new to the industry i.e. a new DSP or Property Finder**



Rules of entry for the first 6 awards:

You must be a member of the ARP or the ARPF

You must send any relevant documentation and complete and return the attached form or the Survey Monkey Questionnaire by Friday 12th April 2019 - entries received after this date will not qualify

Definitions:

- Property Finders are those who work directly with retained private clients
- Destination Service Providers are those who provide services directly to employees – this category is not open to members who only sub-contract services
- Schools & Educational Consultants are those involved in education
- Serviced Accommodation are those who offer serviced accommodation
- Removal Companies are those offering household goods movement
- Specialist Providers are those who provide other services e.g. Solicitors, Vehicle Management, Furniture Rental, Magazines etc.

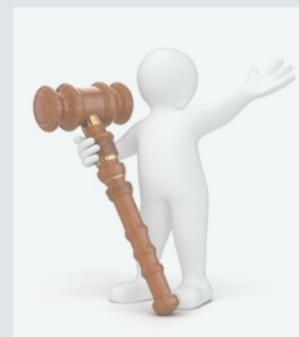
Please submit a 300-word statement:
