### How to Find St Hugh's College

St Hugh's College is located to the north of central Oxford between Canterbury and St Margaret's Roads, about 15 minutes walk from the centre of Oxford.



### Parking - Park&Ride

There are a limited number of parking spaces in the college and on St Margaret's Road outside the college. Most of these are pre reserved for exhibitors and the remaining will fill up quickly, so the alternative is to use the Park and Ride system.

From the A34 (coming from the Banbury direction) at the Pear Tree Roundabout, the Park & Ride is signposted. The 300 bus stops at the junction of Woodstock Road and St Margaret's Road. St Hugh's College entrance can be found on the left hand side of St Margaret's Road. Parking at the Pear Tree Park & Ride is for a maximum of 24 hours and costs £1 and £2.50 for the bus. ### Arriving by Train & Bus

Oxford Station is to the west of the city centre at the end of Park End Street. It is about a 20 minute walk through the centre to the college, but there are plentiful taxi's directly outside. There are regular 24 hour coach services between London and Oxford - taxis' can be found at the bus station.

### Arriving by Air

Stansted: Linked to London Liverpool Street then take the tube to Paddington for trains to Oxford

Luton: Linked to London by train from Luton Airport Parkway Station to St Pancras, then take the tube to Paddington for trains to Oxford
